On May 24<sup>th</sup>, Salem Area Historical Society will be holding its monthly meeting on the fourth Wednesday of the month at the South Salem Stone School (7991 N. Territorial Road) starting at 7:30 PM. The presentation will be the "Great Salem Train Wreck of 1907;

Michigan's Worst Train Wreck" by Joe Oldenburg, historian and archivist. It was a warm summer day on July 20, 1907 as 600 workers, family and friends from the Pere Marquette Railroad shops in Ionia boarded a train at 6 AM for a day long excursion to Boblo Amusement Park on the Detroit River. By 9:14 AM the excursion had turned into a disaster when the excursion train crashed head-on with another Pere Marquette train near 5 Mile and Napier Roads.
