The Gilmore Car Museum is North America's largest auto museum with over 400 vehicles on display and over 209,100 square feet of exhibit space. The Museum's 90-acre Historic Campus features numerous vintage structures including a restored and fully-functioning 1941 Silk City Diner, a recreated 1930s Shell Station, seven onsite Partner Museums, and so much more.
